I. Call to Order

- Meeting was called to order and noted that the meeting was properly noticed. Minutes approved by committee members. Others in attendance were: Josh Grabandt, Vikki Peterson, Curt Timlin. Meeting was also attended by a few community members.

II. Community Outreach

- Superintendent Valenza briefly discussed the plans for a joint meeting/retreat with the Platteville City Council. The city is proposing a December 12th meeting at 5:00 pm with a light supper – held at the Platteville Public Library. This matter will be discussed at the school board meeting being held later this evening with all the board members in attendance.

III. Policy

- Superintendent Valenza explained the first readings of the policy removals, revisions and new policies. Policy Removals include: Policy DBG: Budget Hearings and Reviews, DBJ: Budget Implementation, DBK, Budget Transfer Authority, KM: Relations with Community Organizations, KMA: Relations with Parent Organizations, KMB: Relations with Booster and Other School Support Groups, KNA: Relations with Local Governmental Agencies, KNAJ: Relations with Police Authorities, KNAL: Relations with Civil Defense Authorities, LA: Education Agency Relations Goals, LG: State Educational Agency Relations, LEA-R: Student Teaching Guidelines, LEA: Student Teaching, LE: Relations with University, LBB: Cooperative Education Programs
Policy Revisions include: Policy DB: Annual Operating Budget (which will be revised to Policy 620) and IGDG: Student Activity Funds Management (which will be revised to Policy 662). These policies are being revised and brought into the new numerical system as well as adding some non-substantial updates.
New Policy 880: Relations with Community organizations and Educational and Governmental Agencies. This policy brings all of the individual policies related to community agency relationships under one umbrella policy, includes some minor revision and updating as well as being brought into the new numerical system.
- A concerned community member addressed the board with concerns he has with the Volunteer Coaching Policy. Three other community members briefly addressed the board. Committee members discussed the concerns with the policy. The committee members agreed to meet to discuss additional clarification to the language due to confusion, but the intent of the policy will remain the same. The committee members and others in attendance were thanked for their time at the end of the meeting.
