

FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The School District of Platteville shall provide student lunches through participation in the National School Lunch Program. The business manager shall enter into an agreement with the Department of Public Instruction and the federal government for participation in such child nutrition programs.

As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the school district agrees to the following:

That a school lunch meeting federal regulations be made available for all students.

That free and reduced price lunches be offered to eligible students who apply and who meet the federal income guidelines.

An "offer vs. serve" lunch program option shall be available in the elementary schools.

The business manager, or designee, shall be responsible for the management of the school lunch program, including the purchase of food and materials. The business manager may delegate specific duties in relation to the school food service program to the food service supervisor.

The school district may participate in the School Breakfast Program or other food service programs as approved by the Board.

Food service programs shall be reviewed annually.

The School District of Platteville shall not discriminate in school-sponsored food service programs on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
