The Platteville School District is seeking an academic intervention teacher to work with students in grades 1-4. Applicants must be Wisconsin DPI certified as an Elementary Teacher (Early Childhood-Regular Education or Early Childhood to Middle Childhood). Qualified candidates will have demonstrated: 1) Ability to work well with students of varying abilities and diverse populations within small group and individual settings. 2) Ability to cooperatively plan an instructional program for students identified in need of specific remedial and/or higher level interventions. 3) Knowledge and application of a Response to Intervention (RtI) multi-tiered system of support. 4) Knowledge of research/evidence based reading and math intervention programs and materials. 5) Ability to provide modeling of instructional techniques in reading and math.

In addition, candidates should have the ability to:

- Ascertain through formal and informal assessments, the strengths and weaknesses of individual students in the areas of reading and math and report results to parents and staff.
- Knowledge of and experience with literacy instruction and interventions programs.
- The ability to flexibly schedule time to meet student and teacher needs.
- Utilize progress monitoring tools to determine the effectiveness of instruction/interventions in improving student achievement.
