- **Instructional Program Topics**

- PK-12 Math Update/Reports were presented by each building Principal.
- MS Principal Julius explained the Forward Exam results. He also discussed My Math and Big Ideas curriculum that is currently being used at the middle school. Minutes per day per math class were briefly discussed.
- HSPrincipal Engh explained the high school math courses and the enrollment numbers. “Algebra Ready” was discussed. What works and what doesn’t was shared. The high school is looking for the best option to help each student become successful in math. Academic support and student access to devices are pretty important. Looking for ways to have upper classmen possibly help with the academic support if possible. Superintendent Valenza stated that she would like to see the library become a learning center, not just a library.
- WV/NW Principal Reuter discussed testing and shared data for our current students. Brief discussion on economically disadvantaged and non-economically disadvantaged students and testing results. My Math curriculum seems to be working well with the students. Test scores show a nice comparison between fall and winter. She also stated that device access for each elementary student is pretty important. She believes that the test scores are up due to devices not having to be shared.

- **Co-Curricular Program**

- HS Assistant Principal Foley gave a list of school activities. He stated that our kids do a wonderful job in all the activities that we offer. Hillmen Pride is really starting to show!
