Seeks Public Input in
District Administrator Search Process

The School Board has started the District Administrator search process to replace Connie Valenza who will leave her position in the Platteville School District on June 30, 2019. The School Board has chosen the Wisconsin Association of School Boards (WASB) to assist in this search process.

Focus Groups help the School Board develop screening criteria and interview questions for candidates. The Focus Group input will aid the School Board in finding the candidate who will best match the needs of the School District of the Platteville School District. All Focus Groups will be facilitated by WASB Search Services Consultant.
